

### After school ACT Prep class-

- An after school ACT prep class will be offered Spring semester 2012
- The class will take place at the high school, Mon-Wed from 3:30-5:00 and will include two mock ACT tests administered on Saturdays, at the school
- The class will be taught by Connie Belliveau and Raye Pedigo
- Connie Belliveau will teach the English and Reading portions of the test
- Raye Pedigo will teach the Math and Science portions of the test
- Both teachers have received instructor training from Princeton Review.
- The cost of the class will be \$99 and will be used to cover the cost of the Princeton Review course materials
- This will allow students to take the 18 hour ACT Classroom prep class for \$99 instead of the \$599 normally charged by Princeton Review
- Three separate sections will be offered in the spring semester, allowing assistance to as many students as possible
- Interested students should contact Mrs. Belliveau in RM121 at the high school
- The class fee will have to be paid before Christmas break so that the materials can be ordered.

### Requirements-

Although the course is geared towards the junior class, any student working on their ACT scores is eligible. Students will have to pay the \$99 fee in advance, have an accessible e-mail account, and be available for the two mock ACT tests offered on respective Saturdays.
